With All-on-4, a patient missing or soon-to-be missing an entire arch of teeth can literally walk into the dental office and leave with a full set of temporary teeth on the same day!

Although dental implants are a standard service in dentistry, many patients who need dental implants most are not in a position to benefit from this treatment. They often suffer from mild to advanced bone resorption, which means they may require bone grafts or other procedures to prepare for implants.
