Q: Why choose the DFW Dental Implant Center? A: Simply put—choose us for quality, technology, convenience and experience. We use the latest in the digital radiography, including low-dose digital x-rays and an in-office 3D CAT scan machine to evaluate your teeth. We also offer the latest restorative treatment options, including milled zirconia and titanium frameworks, plus all-porcelain veneers, crowns and bridges. All dentistry is done under one roof, meaning I perform both the surgical and restorative aspects of dental implant treatment, including tooth extractions, bone grafting, implant placement and delivery of your new teeth in our office. And, our in-office lab allows us to perform treatment quicker and more predictably by keeping various aspects of dental treatment in-house. We are also able to perform same day denture relines and repairs. Our friendly, professional dental team focuses on one dental patient at a time. And our flexible payment options mean we accept all major credit cards, PPO dental insurance plans, checks, cash and CareCredit® for third-party financing.

Q: What exactly is a Prosthodontist? A: A Prosthodontist is a dental specialist who has completed four years of dental school plus three additional years of advanced training and education in an ADA-accredited prosthodontic graduate program. This rigorous training gives Prosthodontists a special understanding of the dynamics of a smile and the preservation of a healthy mouth.

Q: What are dental implants? A: A dental implant is a small titanium post that functions as an artificial root or an anchor. The dental implant connects directly to an abutment, which then connects directly to a single implant crown, implant bridge, implant denture or full-arch fixed bridge to replace one or more missing teeth.

Q: Do you accept my dental insurance and do they cover dental implants? A: We accept all major PPO dental insurance plans, including Delta Dental, Cigna and MetLife to name a few. If you need help understanding your insurance plan or want us to file a claim on your behalf, please let us know and we will be glad to do that. Most PPO dental insurance plans will cover up to 50% of the dental implant, abutment and crown up to your yearly maximum. If your dental insurance plan does not cover the placement of the dental implant, your insurance will most likely cover to have the abutment and crown placed. If you need help with your dental insurance, please call our office for assistance.

Q: Are payment plans available for my dental treatment? A: We do not offer any in-office payment plans, but we do accept CareCredit as an option to make monthly payments to a third-party. The interest rates are very competitive and are interest free for up to 12 months. We also accept cash, checks, and American Express, Discover, MasterCard and Visa. These options make implants an affordable choice for patients.

Q: How successful are dental implants and is age a factor? A: Implants have been successfully placed since the 1950s. With many ongoing technological advancements and more durable implant materials, the 10 year success rates have been reported at 93 percent or better. With no age restrictions for dental implants, it's available to all.
